- April 8-11= NOCTI Written Exams- schedule will not change for Juniata County or Mifflin Count Students
- April 16= NOCTI Performance Exams- students completing performance exams will remain at the Academy all day until finished and will not report to MCHS, East Juniata or Juniata High Schools. Academy students not testing will report to Mifflin County Middle School
- April 24= Family Night 5:00 p.m. -7:00 p.m.- program showcase event is open to current and alumni students and their families (including those just accepted into the program)
- May 14= Signing Day (at the Armory) = Event starts at 1:00 p.m. Participants will be required to provide their own transportation to the Armory. The rest of the student body and staff will remain at the Academy.
- May 15= Field Day and Class Awards- Awards will given out during an assembly in the
 cafeteria (an assembly for each session). There will be concessions, games and other
 activities during the remaining portion of each session.
- May 19 = Academy Awards practice at MCHS 12:30 p.m. Mifflin County Seniors will remain at MCHS and eat B lunch. Juniata County Seniors should be dropped at Mifflin County High School at 12:40 p.m. and then the remainder of the Juniata County students can be taken to the Academy.
- May 20 = Academy Awards Night 7:00 p.m. at MCHS. Seniors should report to the Band Room at Mifflin County High School between 6:00 p.m. and 6:15 p.m. to get their gown and then line up for the processional.
- May 21 = Seniors still report to the Academy and follow their normal schedule
- May 22= Seniors will be dismissed from MCHS at 1:30 p.m. Seniors will report to the Academy at their regular time and eat lunch at the Academy and then will be bused back to MCHS for their meeting
- May 23= Last day for Juniata County Seniors
